### **Explanation of Responses:**

- 1. Option vests over four years, with 25% of the shares vesting on July 1, 2020, and 75% of the shares vesting in 36 equal monthly installments thereafter, subject to the reporting person's continued service with the Issuer through the applicable vesting date.
- 2. Option vests over four years, with 1/48th of the shares vesting on each monthly anniversary of March 1, 2021, subject to the reporting person's continued service with the Issuer through the applicable vesting date.
- 3. Option vests over four years, with 20.8333% of the shares vesting on January 1, 2022, and with 79.1667% of the shares vesting in 38 equal monthly installments thereafter, subject to the consummation of the Issuer's initial public offering and the reporting person's continued service with the Issuer through the applicable vesting date.
